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# OVERVIEW

The Utilities application is a DTCC web-based tool accessed from MyDTCC.

The web upload functionality enables upload of operational files outside of standard connectivity channels, including:

- When your existing DTCC connectivity and operating conditions are unavailable or not functioning as expected. This contingency solution ensures that critical files can still enter DTCC workflows when there is a disruption to your standard connectivity setup or mainframe transfers. DTCC expects that you use the standard Connectivity set up with DTCC as the preferred file transmission and retrieval mechanism.
- As a standalone file upload solution to submit and retrieve files when you have not set up DTCC connectivity.

It also enables you to view reports related to the files you uploaded.

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# ACCESS

## Obtaining Utilities Access

Request your firm's Super Access Coordinator (SAC) to provide access through the Customer Registration System (CRS).

SACs perform the following processes in the Client Registration System (CRS) to grant user access to the UTF system:

- Whitelist users for both UTF access (Utilities) and upload capabilities (Upload).
- Link an appropriate Originator Code (OCODE) to a TAG, a requirement from the CRS perspective. The OCODE must be eligible in the Common Data Transfer System (CDTS) to enable file submission.

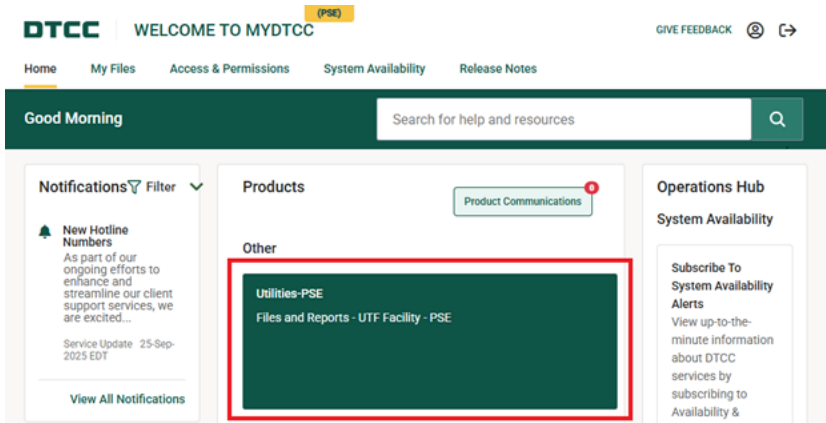
Once entitlements are approved, you will be able to log into [MyDTCC](#) and access the Utilities application.

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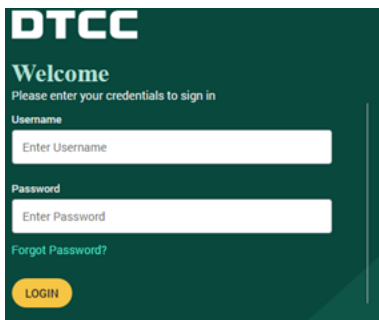

## Logging into the Utilities Application

1. Open the MyDTCC **Production** or **Non-Production** or portal login page.



2. After authentication, select the TAG (Transaction Account Group) you want to use from the

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**Transaction Account Group (TAG) selection screen that appears and press **Submit**.**

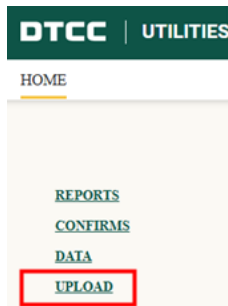
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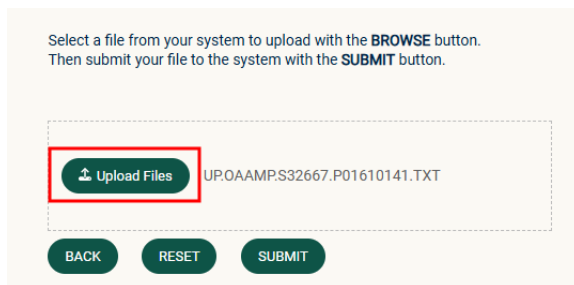
# UTILITIES MENU

## Uploading a File to Utilities

1. Click **Upload** from the Utilities menu.



2. Click **Upload Files** and browse to the desired file.



3. Click **Submit**. A success message is displayed.

## File Upload Conditions

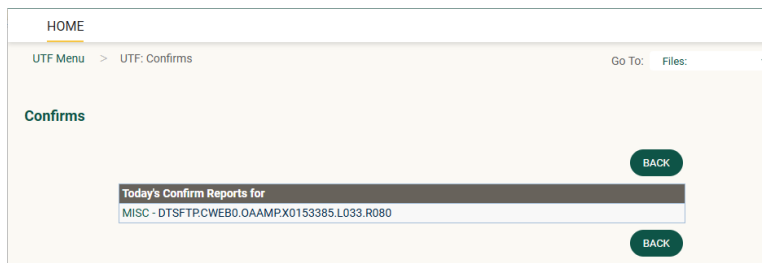
Upload Conditions	Limit/Allowed Values
Number of Orders per day	No limit
Maximum file size	100MB
Accepted file formats	CSV, Flat text file
Blacklisted file types (do not upload)	.dll, .exe, .pdf, .doc, .docx, .sh, .bat

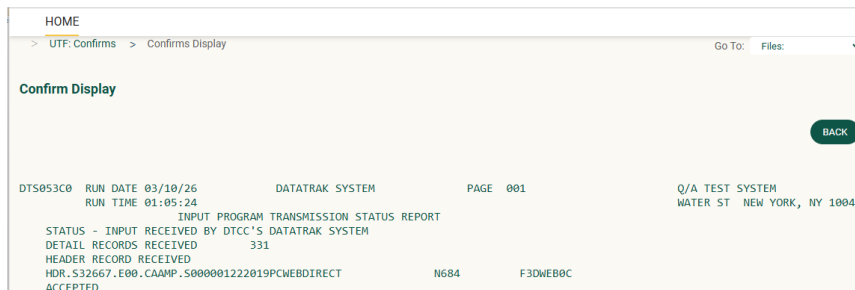
## Confirming Utilities File Uploads

1. View a list of files uploaded today from the **Home > Confirms** tab.



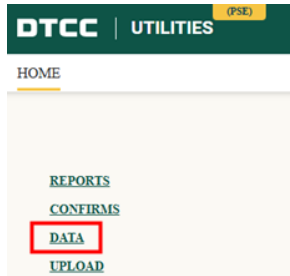
2. Click the file to display a file summary.

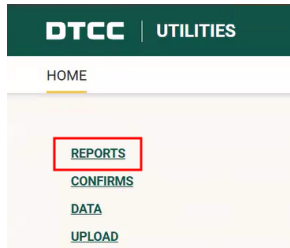

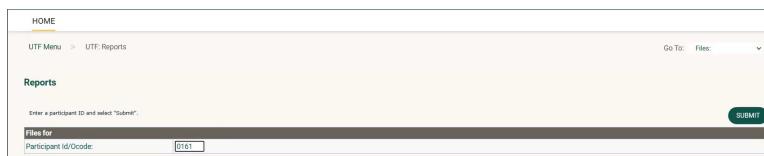
# Viewing Utilities Reports

Follow this procedure to view the contents of your uploaded files.

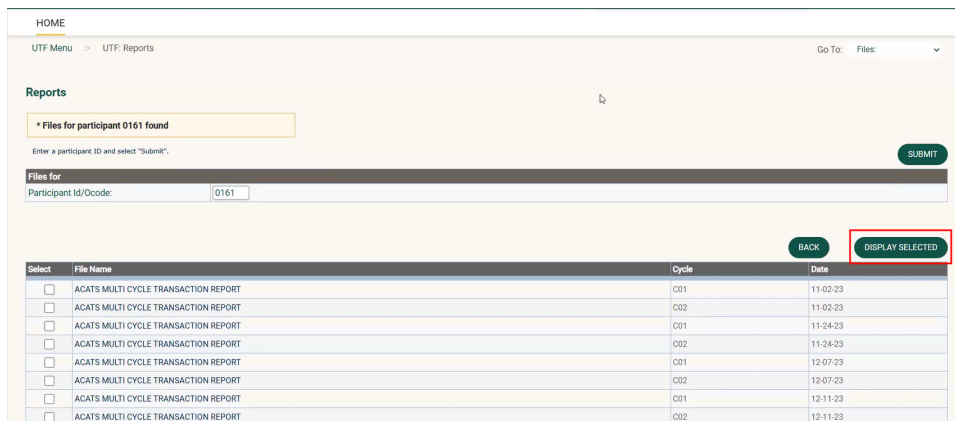
1. Click **Reports** from the main Utilities menu to open the Reports screen.

## Common Utilities Errors and Troubleshooting

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# APPENDIX: ANIRA AND NETGATE

## AT&T Global Network Client DNS Configuration (ANIRA / Netgate)

When accessing Utilities via a .net URL, you must download and install the **AT&T Global Network Client** software from the AT&T website. If you already have the AT&T Global Network Client installed, ensure that you are using the latest version available from AT&T.

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### Note

This section only describes DNS configuration required to enable UTF access. For installation, usage, and other configuration details related to the AT&T Global Network Client, refer to AT&T's official documentation.

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To configure DNS on the AT&T Global Network Client:

1. From the Settings menu, select **Login properties**.
2. In the Servers section, click the **Configure** button.
3. In the **Use the following manual settings** from the DNS pop up page, enter the following field information and click **Next**:

Name	Description
Primary DNS	207.45.35.1
Secondary DNS	207.45.35.244
DNS Domain	dtcc.net
DNS Port	Tcp 53 OR udp 53

4. In the WINS pop up page, select **Use default network settings**, and then click **Next**.
5. In the Domain suffix page, select **Use default network settings**, then click **Finish**.
6. Connect to your VPN account and access the new web URLs.

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## ANIRA Netgate: PSE (Test) and Production Environments

Add the following information to the /etc./hosts local host file.

The Utilities tool does not require any additional firewall rules beyond the existing AT&T ANIRA/Netgate network configuration.
